Chhatra for her 95th birthday

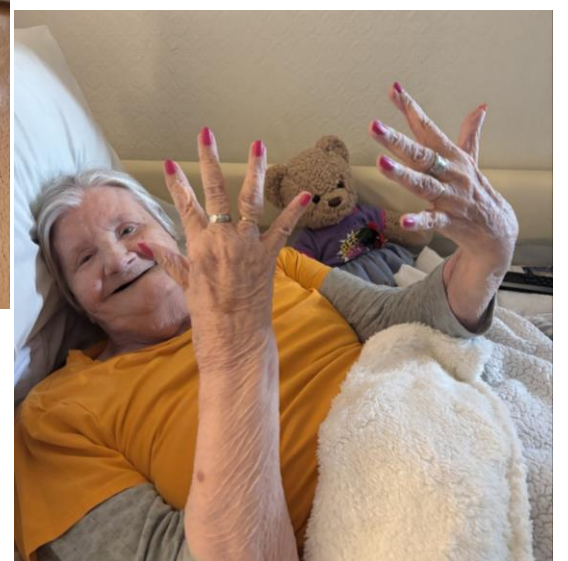
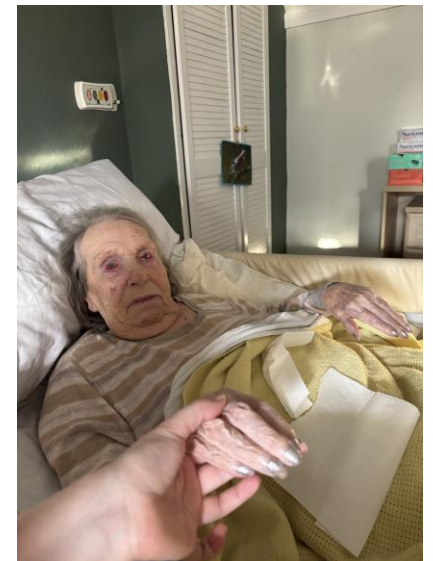
We hope that she had a lovely day.



We had artist Dennis enter the building, creating a very colourful picture!

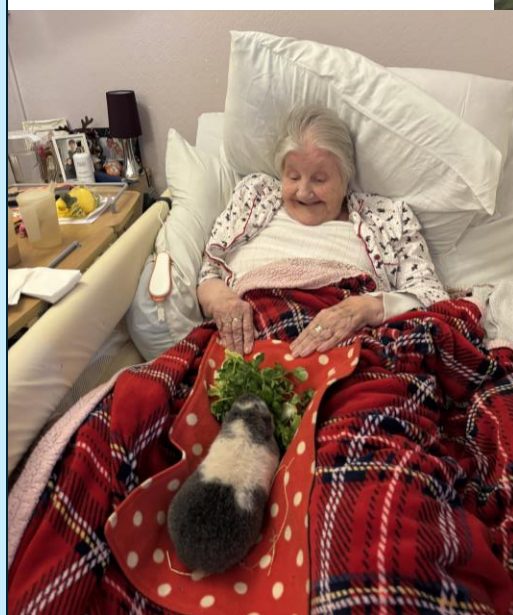


Some of our residents have enjoyed having their nails painted and a nice pamper. They love choosing their colours or designs..
