Entertainment and Activities

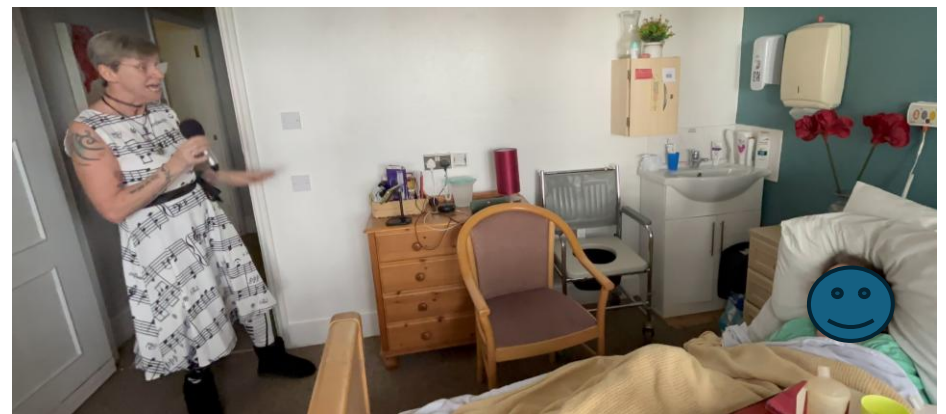
In Feb we celebrated a few of our residents' birthdays. They all celebrated with their families and had a delicious cake made for them by our chef.

To mark the year of the horse, our residents tried some Chinese tea and had some fortune cookies!



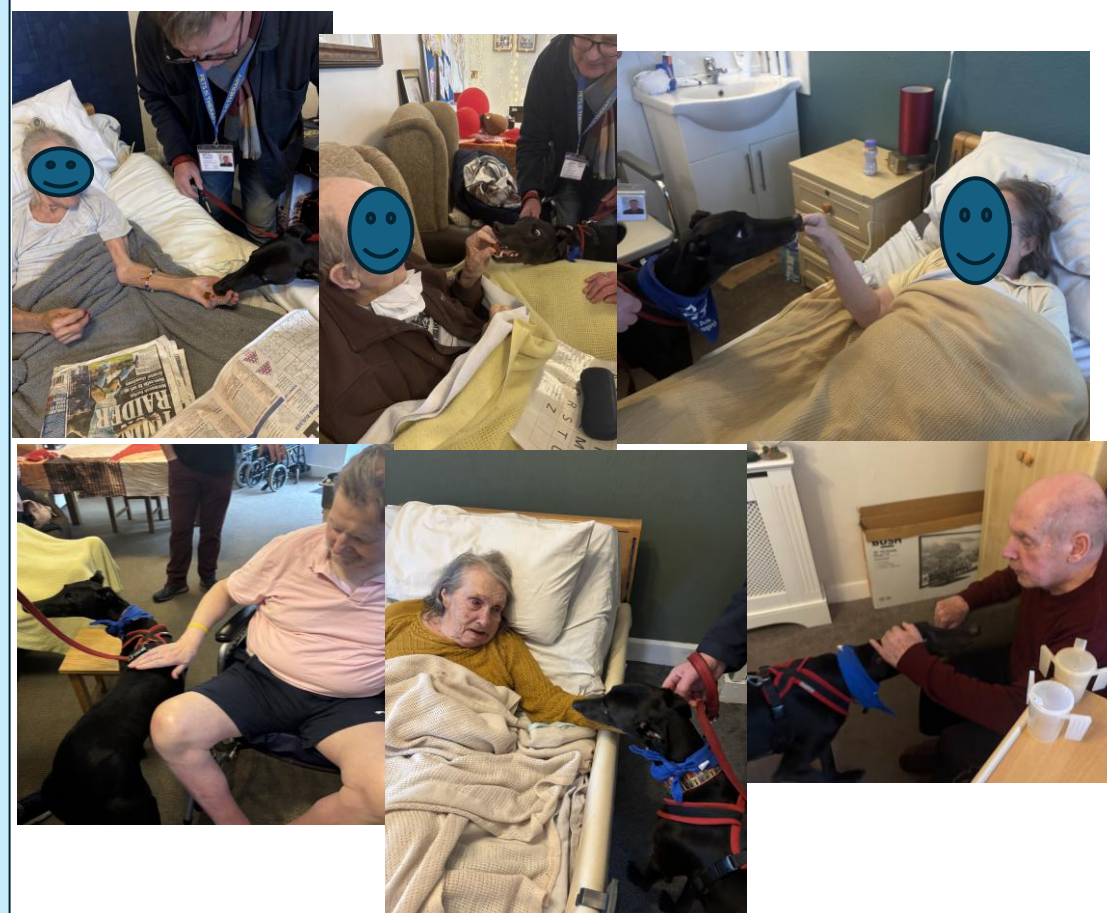
The children from Little Oaks came for an adventure around the home where they searched for different flags around the home and learnt about that country, with a nursery rhyme to go with it.
