Entertainment and Activities

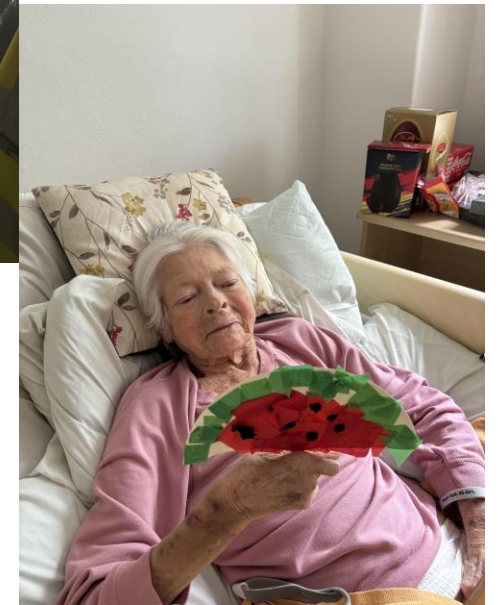

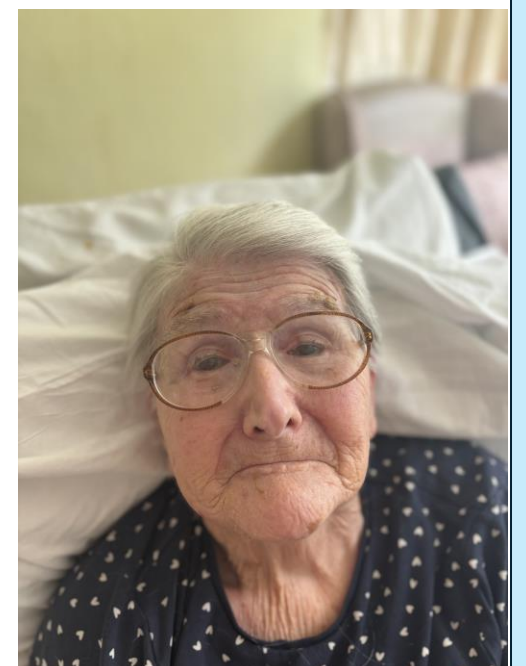
On June 15th we surprised our Father's with some gifts from the home to celebrate Father's Day!
