Entertainment and Activities

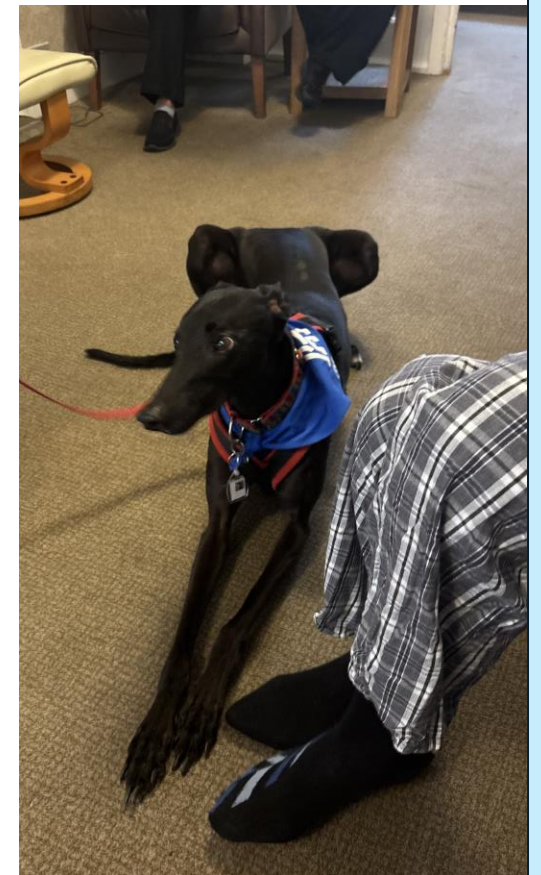
